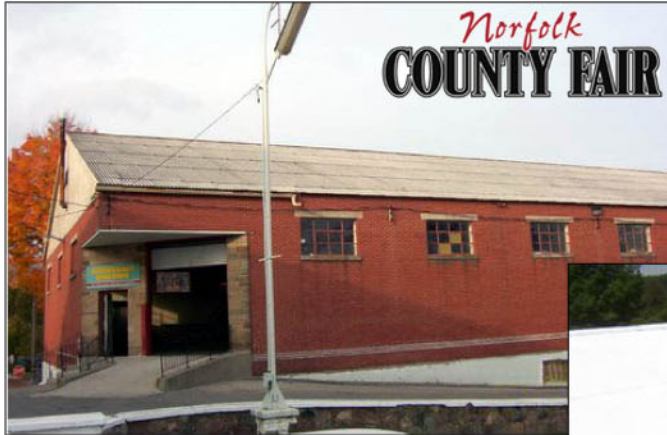


Topps Seal™ Is “Best of Show” At Fairgrounds

The Norfolk County Fair — at 165 years and counting — is one of Canada’s oldest agricultural fairs. Each year over 120,000 people visit the fair to see the agricultural displays, craft exhibits, food vendors, art demonstrations, talent competitions, midway rides and special events.



Topps was chosen to renew one of the fair’s display buildings. The corrugated asbestos roof was in generally good condition but the years had left it leaking in spots and looking run-down. A complete Topps renewal revived the roof, stopping leaks and cooling the building.



Did you know? Corn dogs, hot dogs in a fried cornmeal batter, were first introduced at the Texas State Fair in 1942.

TOPPS became part of the Kansas State Fair’s Facilities Master Plan by renewing the roof of their fine arts display building. The 25-year-old building will now be more comfortable for the 300,000+ people who visit the fair annually.
